Dear Parents and Families,

We are very excited to be welcoming Kindergarten children back onto school site this week and it has been lovely to hear and see them playing and catching up with their friends.

With Christmas just around the corner, I am going to ask for your co-operation in supporting the school community to stay as Covid-19 free as we can possibly be for the last days of term.

If the school has a case of COVID at any point between Friday December 11th and the last day of term Wednesday December 16th, any children or staff that are affected will have to quarantine for Christmas Day and beyond. This would be potentially quite distressing for families and relatives of staff. In particular, we are concerned about the area just outside the school gate and reducing congestion. I am therefore asking parents from Monday 7th December to:

- **Wear masks/face-coverings when dropping off or collecting your children**
- **Only one parent per family to reduce contact at the school gate**
- **If you do arrive early, please either wait in your car or at a distance from the school and each other.**
