This is the first title in the Alien Shooter series followed by Alien Shooter: Vengeance. Alien Shooter has two expansions, Fight for Life, released on June 14, 2004 and The Experiment, released on September 22, 2004, which each has five new levels and includes conclusions for the Alien Shooter story. Character Gameplay has 4 stats: Strength, Accuracy (accuracy and better damage), Health and Speed. Players can start with male characters (stronger and have more health) or female (faster and more accurate). Alien Shooter is presented in a top-down view (3/4 perspective). The game consists of 9 levels with increasing difficulty. The goal of each level is to kill all the aliens. To achieve this, players need to access all areas of the level (by reactivating power plants, destroying walls, disabling force field, etc.) and killing aliens. Then the level has a teleportation device, which gives birth to unlimited enemies and can only be destroyed by special explosives scattered throughout the level. The slain alien dropped a pickup, consisting of money, health and ammunition among other items. Between levels, players can buy more powerful weapons in the store. It is also possible to buy a permanent increase to 4 statistics. Temporary upgrades can be purchased including Lives, Body Armor, Attack Drones, etc. Most of the items in the store can also be found at the level. [1] Plot After contact is lost with an underground laboratory and several failed military attacks, the protagonist is sent to investigate. After infiltrating the complex, players find it invaded by aliens. The cause was found to be an experimental teleportation device. Aliens have flowed through teleporters and gathered within the confines of the lab. As the protagonist goes deeper into the complex, more and more powerful aliens are encountered.
