Carrie Mae Rose is an American fine artist, known primarily for her sculpture, installation, print, and performance work. Her practice integrates meditation-based visioning with research into alchemy, myth, and cultural narratives. She translates these inquiries into artworks that activate symbols such as wings, flames, lightning, and suns as devotional technologies—visual tools for resilience, reflection, and cultural transformation. Drawing on the traditions of thangkas, mandalas, yantras, and divine weapons, Rose reimagines symbolic forms as instruments for human clarity, collective strength, and a new culture of wisdom where each person feels safe enough to feel beautiful.
