Saint Manicka vasagar and 'Sivapuranam'

Saint Manicka vasagar lived in the district of Madurai, South India. According to Dr. G.U. Pope, he belonged to the 7% or 8% century. He was a precocious child and became prime minister under a Pandiya king. He was one of the long line of Saiva saints who through their devotional songs succeeded in recovering the Saiva faith from the Buddhists and the Jains who considered their relieion to be superior.

The collection of the saint's work is titled *Thiruvasagann* meaning 'Sacred Utterances'. They are so moving that tradition considers that a heart that is not touched by them must have a heart of stone.

This composition of only 95 lines is recited largely all round the world by practicing Saiva Hindus. Though popular, its content is rather complex because of its philosophic rhetoric. It is the 'story' – 'puranam' –about Shiva and hence the title 'Sivapuranam'. Shiva is the supreme God of the Hindus. The saint focuses on the God in the Temple at Thiruperunthurai, a seaport city near Madurai for the major part and towards the end shifts to the deity in Chidambaram, further down South, known as Nataraja, the cosmic dancer.

Puranam refers to any 'story' with a principal deity or deities as the central figure/s. The underlying story may be real or partly real. Possibly it is a mix of different components – history, legends, myths
