That's why laptop manufacturers please us with new and new solutions that can offer a wealth of shapes and configurations for all the needs and tastes of the modern user. A striking example is Lenovo, which recently brought to the Ukrainian market another laptop - Lenovo 50-75, characterized by high performance and good multimedia capabilities. The novelty managed to get into our test laboratory, and we are in a hurry to share with you the results of acquaintance with it. It should be noted that this model is made in the most popular mid-size format with the following classic style. In addition, the laptop is made in different sets, which primarily differ between models of processors and graphics cards, as well as the type of drives. In our case, the test sample is based on the top-end AMD FX-7500 processor combined with the discrete graphics of the AMD Radeon R7 M260DX and the HDD 1TB drive. The specifications of the Supply and Trim Laptop comes in classic eco-packed, made of plain dense cardboard. The design is traditionally minimalistic: several logos and stickers with information about the delivery kit, as well as the specifications of the novelty. The Lenovo test sample includes The minimum you need to get started: a rechargeable battery, a compact power supply with a cable to connect to the network, a drive from drivers, and technical documentation. There is also an additional range of accessories and services that can be purchased separately. Their full list is available on the manufacturer's website. Appearance, the location of elements design Lenovo 50-75 is made in the classic restrained, but no less pleasant style with familiar features characteristic of this manufacturer. The novelty is available in the traditional color scheme - black and white. The dimensions (384 x 265 x 25 mm) and weight (2.4 kg), both for a 15.6-inch mobile computer, are also fairly standard. The laptop cover is made of velvety matte plastic, which changes its hue depending on the lighting conditions. Plastic provides a pleasant tactile sensation and almost complete absence of prints and stains (depending on the lighting conditions). But it is sensitive to mechanical influence: it can be scratched quite easily. Closer to the side faces of the lid has smooth rounding, which adds to the device of sophistication. In the top corner is a shiny Lenovo logo. The side faces of the laptop are somewhat deepened and have a different color from the lid and the bottom of the case. The latter is made of non-marked and non-slip matte plastic with a characteristic relief texture. On the basis is a flat (with vents) interchangeable panel (attached by three screws) for quick access to the internal components of the system in case of their replacement or service cleaning. Also There are four large legs for the reliable fixation of the device on flat surfaces. Closer to the front panel, holes are placed on the sides to make sound out of the stereo speakers. On the opposite side is a battery compartment and a sticker with general technical information. The front panel has a somewhat beveled profile, which visually reduces the thickness of the laptop. There are only two LED lights: Power and Battery. On the back, except for the hinge of the display block, there is nothing. On the left side face are: a rectangular socket to connect the power adapter, a microscopic key to launch Lenovo OneKey Recovery, a wide perforated area for heated air, D-Sub (VGA) and RJ45 connectors (with a folding cover), an HDMI port, as well as one USB 2.0 and USB 3.0. On the opposite side is a combined mini-jack 3.5 mm audio connector (to connect acoustics/headphones or microphone), a memory card reader (SD, MMC, SDXC, SDHC), USB 2.0 port, optical drive tray and Kensington security lock. The Lenovo 50-75 workbar is covered with a sheet of aluminum with a vertical polished texture (well collects prints and needs appropriate care) and cutouts under the keyboard block and touchpad. The latter is closer to the left edge. It has a silver edging and considerable size. There is also a sticker showing the model and key features. On the opposite side is the AMD FX logo, which gives the user the first idea of the device's hardware platform used. Full keyboard a little deeper. Closer to the display is a kind of ledge (when closed hides in the corresponding neckline) with the logo Dolby which visually dilutes the look of the work area and serves as a receptacle for the battery. To the left of the ledge is a power key (deprived of illumination), which has a tight and clear press, protecting it from accidental activation. On the contour of the workbar there is a edging, which acts as a stop for the display block. The display unit is attached to the base with two loops on the sides, which provide a reliable fixation. Despite this, it is quite easy to open the Lenovo 50-75 with one hand. The maximum opening angle is standard (approximately 135) and is sufficient for most usage scenarios. The edging around the display is made of glossy plastic, which has inherent flaws. Here on the contour are rubber legs to protect the matrix in a closed position. At the upper central part is a webcam peephole (with an indicator) and two stereo microphones. If we talk about the overall rigidity of the structure, it is at the average level. The hull is twisted even with little impact, but it is not critical and inconspicuous in everyday operating conditions. When you try to pressure (including on the keyboard unit), the laptop is not deformed. The build quality is good: there are almost no backlashes and gaps; nothing creaks in normal use. In general, the Lenovo 50-75 is a classic laptop with a pleasant and rather stylish design, which will be equally good in the arsenal of a business person or young people. The novelty is characterized by the use of quality materials and good build quality, which can not but please. Input Devices In the Lenovo model, the 50-75 features the island-style AccuType's signature full-size keyboard with an additional digital unit that many might need (hello to accountants, students, and programmers). The keyboard layout is presented in the classic American version (US ANSI) with a single-level Enter and oblong Left Shift and Backspace. The keys themselves have the signature shape of the caps. They are based on the scissors system and have the following dimensions: basic - 15 x 15 mm; Functional range - 13 x 8 mm; The digital unit is 15 x 15 mm. The keys have a pleasant short and almost silent move, which is characterized by medium-expressed recoil with a clear moment of triggering. There are no additional keys. The only remark is not a very convenient block of arrows, which is placed in the same row with the other keys and is not highlighted, but it can be quite easy to get used to. The symbols are printed with the usual division into basic (white) and functional (orange) keys. It should be noted that the keys F4 and F5 are tied to the functions Close and Update, which does not require the use of combinations Fn the area for resting hands wrists has a considerable size, so with long work they almost do not get tired. The base of the keyboard block is quite well fixed, so it is almost not pressed even in the central part. has considerable size (100 x 53 mm) and has dedicated keys. The latter are a bit tight in pressing and are characterized by a characteristic click of moderate volume. Sliding your fingers on the touchpad is quite pleasant. The basic sensitivity is a little overpriced, but it easily adjusts in the driver. Press processing is at a high level. There is also support for multitouch gestures. You can't turn off the touchpad. The display, webcam, sound Laptop Lenovo 50-75 is equipped with a 15.6-inch display BOE HB156FH1-301 with a resolution of 1920 x 1080 (Full HD), which is the unconditional advantage of the novelty. The matrix itself is made according to the technology of TN'film and has a glossy coating and WLED-lights. It is characterized by quite good viewing angles (with optimal perpendicular position in front of the screen) and contrast, as well as a sufficient margin of brightness for home use. But because of the features of the coating actively collects dust particles and can glare under direct sunlight. In addition, the display is problematic with the display of gradients, which is especially noticeable when watching videos or in games. Most likely, this is a feature of only a specific test sample. The webcam is represented by a 1.3-megapixel module, which is equipped with two directional microphones and an indicator of work. There is the possibility of shooting video with a resolution of 1280 x 720 (HD). This is enough to get a fairly high-quality picture and sound during all sorts of web conferences and video calls. The Lenovo 50-75 sound subsystem is represented by two speakers with Dolby Home Theater technology, located closer to the back of the base. The sound codec plays a fairly new Conexant CX20751/2. Low frequencies are almost non-existent, as is the feeling of volume, but the sound is quite loud and clean even at maximum volume. In general, the audio subsystem should be enough to watch video or gameplay comfortably, and if necessary, you can connect headphones or external acoustics.
