



Infantry units in the military are carefully structured and generally follow a similar pattern of organization. The smallest unit is the "fire team", made up of four soldiers who work very closely with each other, training together and even living together in a combat environment. There is virtually nothing these soldiers don't know about the other members of their team, and military history is full of examples of fire team members giving their lives for one another without hesitation.

9. Childhood victim of sexual assault by a role model From parents, priests, pastors, uncles, coaches.



### **PHASE TWO**


- 1.Build the "Be the storm" movement in other churches in the Las Vegas Valley.








- 3. Mark things you need help in understanding.


  Mark things you would need help in applying to your life.






