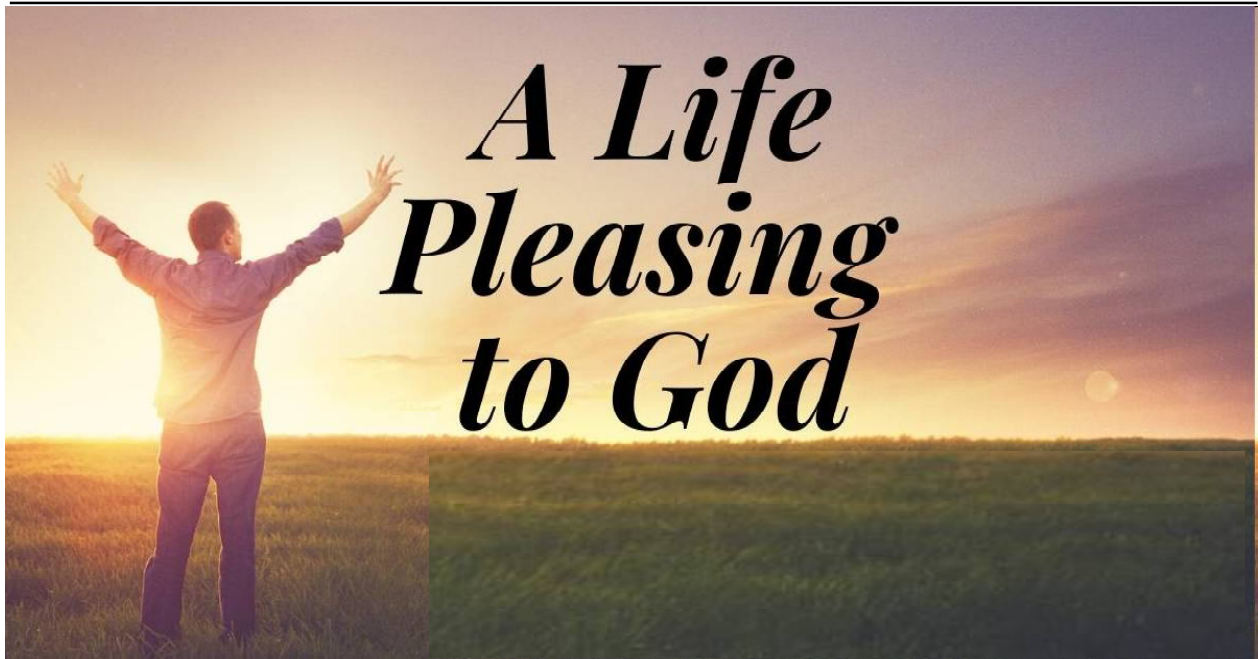


Household of Faith fidelity
