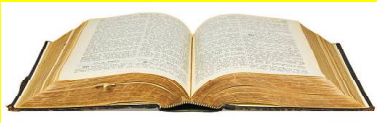

Daily Divine Appointments

As Christians, we believe that our lives are in God's hands. Whatever happens to us is because He loves us, watches over us and is protecting us. Nothing will happen to us that we cannot bear. All things will work together for our good. Ponder on these two promises.

1 Corinthians 10:13 - *No temptation has taken you except what is common to man. God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted above what you are able, but will with the temptation also make the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it.*

Romans 8:28 - *We know that all things work together for good for those who love God, to those who are called according to his purpose.*

Just like the apostles, we need to *"lift up your eyes, and look at the fields"* - John 4:35

Each day, God is walking with us, leading us to all kinds of divine appointments. It is so important that we be alert to every opportunity as it will bless our lives so much.

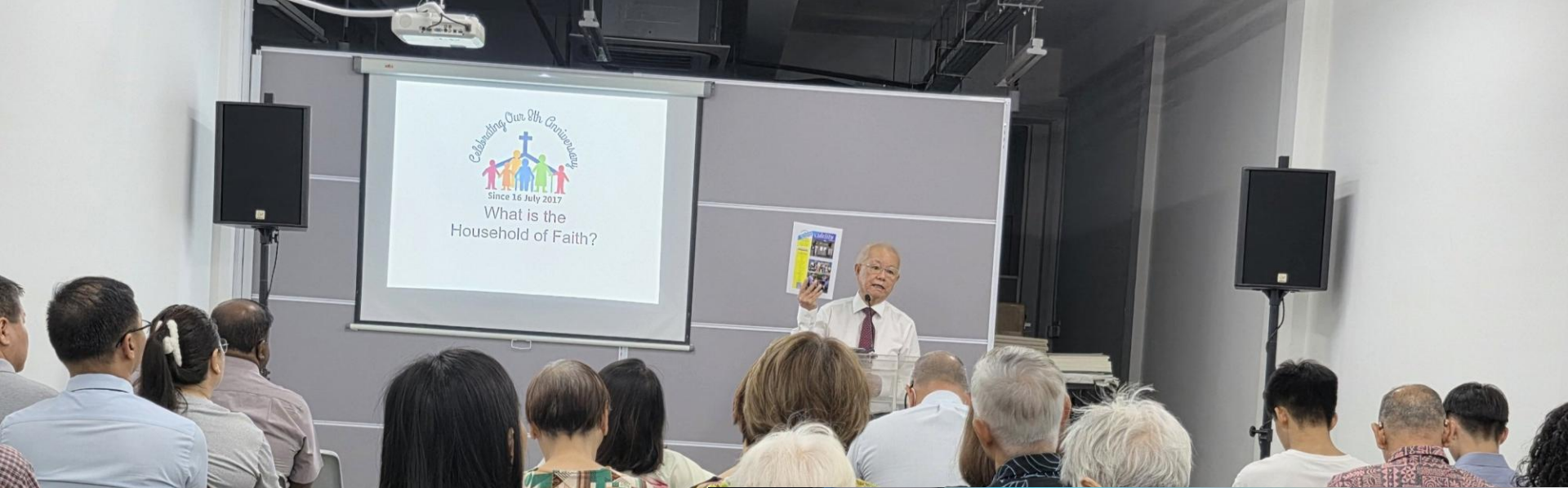

God's Crowning Glory

Genesis 2:7

Then the Lord God formed the man of dust from the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living creature.

Genesis 1:26

Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. And let them have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over the livestock and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

Genesis 1:27

God created man in his own image. In God's image he created him; male and female he created them.

Of all of God's creation, only man is created in His image

- Landscape
- Vegetation
- Animals

Genesis 2:7

And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

Genesis 2:16-17

Yahweh God commanded the man, saying, "Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat: but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, you shall not eat of it: for in the day that you eat of it you will surely die."

Not so with angels after the rebellion

As such, we will have to acknowledge while we passionately want to save the lost; they have the right to refuse to heed to our message and suffer the consequences.

For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ

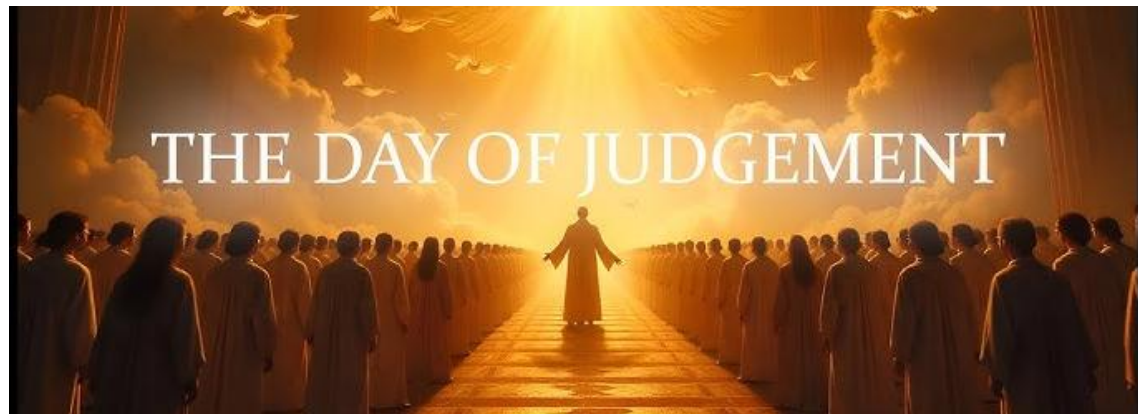
- The only way to escape judgment is to confess our sins and seek cleansing from God
