Acrylic Painting Workshop

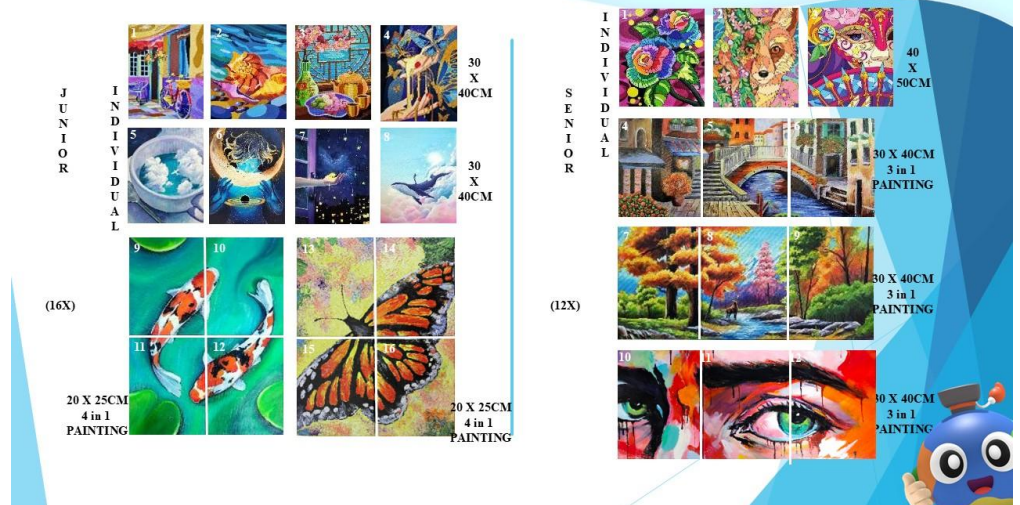
For students who want to try out acrylic painting, we will continue to run the monthly acrylic painting workshop.



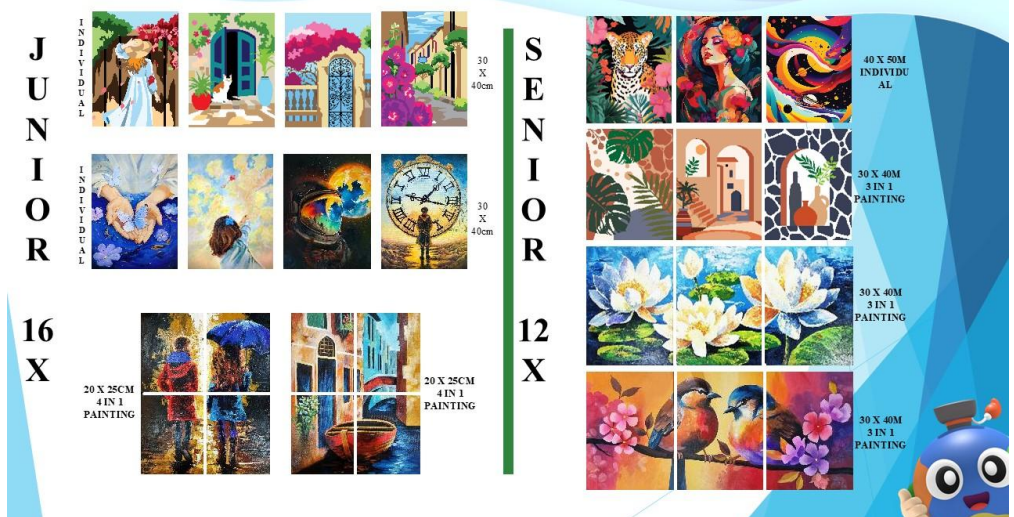
Acrylic Painting Series

"Isaak Chia" (Age: 5)

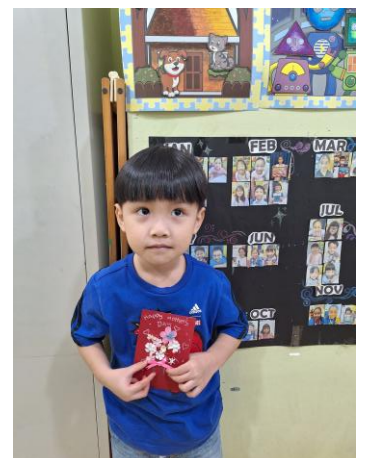
