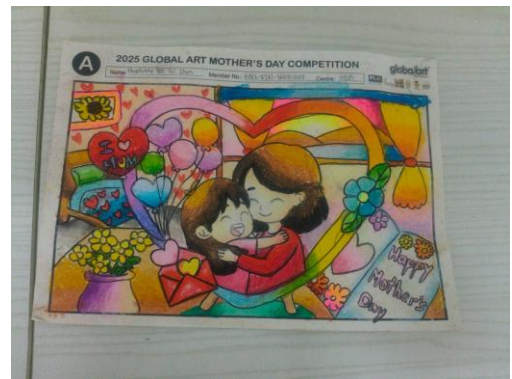

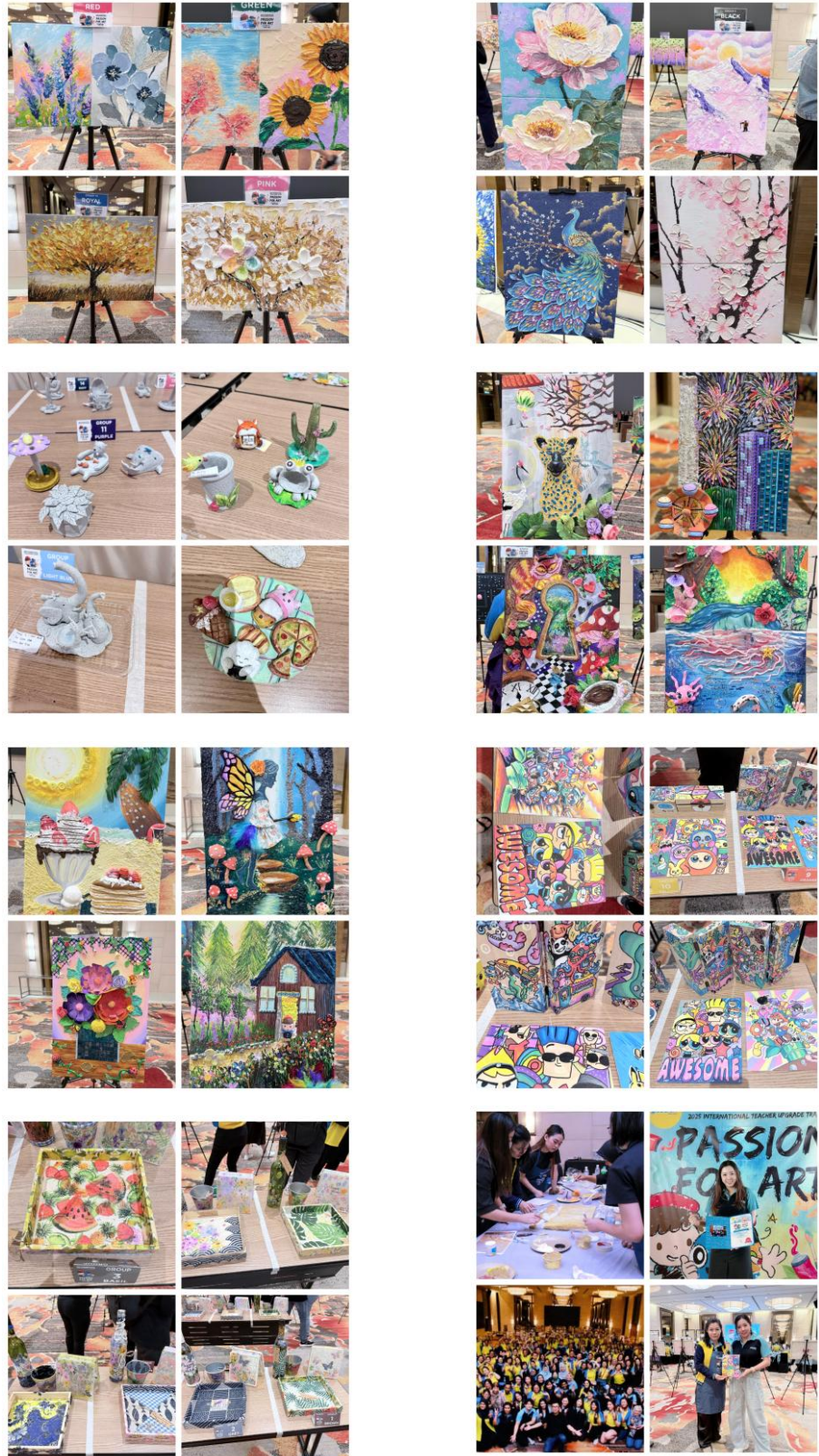




Teacher Upgrading Training – June 2025
