Johnny teaches musicians every Saturday afternoon.

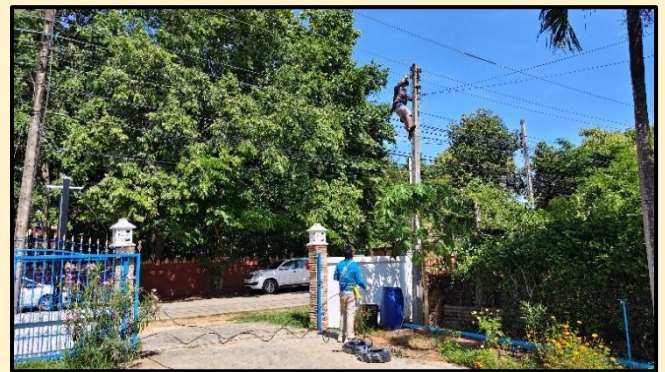

We ask you to pray for wisdom as we move forward, for God's provision for these projects, and for continued growth as we reach our community with the gospel. Thank you for faithfully partnering with us through your prayers and generous support. We are grateful for each of you and excited to see what the Lord will do in this next chapter of ministry.
