02 **Ecclesiastes 3:11:**


~ 11 He has made everything beautiful in its time. He has also set eternity in the human heart; yet no one can fathom what God has done from beginning to end.






Joseph, son of Jacob

There is no such thing as “good news” or “bad news” ----- it’s only how **WE** respond to it...


(I mean who am I to say this... I'm just a kid)

No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Yet later it yields righteousness.


- *God allows certain things / events in our lives to show how much we need Him.*
 - *“Godly-Dependence”*



- Delayed Gratification vs Instant Gratification
- ~ If you noticed, many of the parables are described as “*Slow-Growth*”
 - *Sowing the Seeds...*
 - *Reaping the Harvest...*
 - *Drinking Milk → Eating Meat*

Hebrews 5:12-14:

In fact, though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you the elementary truths of God’s word all over again. You need milk, not solid food! Anyone who lives on milk, being still an infant, is not acquainted with the teaching about righteousness. But solid food is for the mature, who by constant use have trained themselves to distinguish good from evil.
