DEVOTIONAL: WEEK TWO (THE LORD'S KINGDOM)

1. When you pray to God, "*Your Kingdom come*" what does that mean? Write down what the Kingdom of God looks like as it is described in the Bible.
2. If you lived your life, and walked in the Kingdom of God everyday, how would your life be different? At home, your job, at church, etc:
3. Read Isaiah 2:4 & 11:6-8. Do you have a hard time believing these verses? Why or why not?
4. Think about this: How would the world be different if it just did what God wanted? How would your personal life be different if you did what God wanted?
5. What did you think of Gordon McDonald's quote from Sunday? "*The Bible writers do their best to paint a picture of Heaven. The picture of Heaven is more than we could ever ask or imagine. Whatever the writers describe for us is nothing compared to what it will actually be.*"
6. Read Philippians 4:6. If you prayed "*Lord, Your Will in my life, as it is in Heaven*" how does that change some things for you? Would you worry less and pray more?
7. What part does the Holy Spirit play in your life when you pray, "*Your Kingdom come?*"
8. Read Luke 17:20-21. Do you believe the 'Kingdom of Heaven' is available for you today? How does the presence of God living inside of you help you with this question?
9. How can you walk in the Kingdom, and live in the presence and power of God? Read Hebrews 12:2. Does this passage help?
10. Do you believe the Kingdom of God and His Will starts with prayer? Why or why not? What if you prayed, "*God, Your Kingdom come at RCC?*" How would God use you through that prayer when it comes to your mindset, your giving and the way you serve? What if you prayed, "Father, I am ALL IN!"?
