I know how to use *67 at home when I want to do this but cell dialing is different – you don't get that double dial tone to tell you that you're limiting your number now. With your cell, just start the number you're calling from *67, as the phone number starts with those three digits. The important thing to remember is that you need to insert 1 before the area code, because the cells normally enter *6719175551212 before hitting the talk button, the receiver will lead the restricted to read caller ID.
