What does that mean? Walgreens and CVS pharmacists plan to check a patient's temperature and wear face shields for the first time when delivering flu vaccines. The country's two largest pharmacy chains are currently offering a seasonal influenza vaccine with new precautions. The deployment comes amid swirling concerns about the collision of the COVID-19 pandemic with the flu season, which is expected to strain the health system. Before administering immunization, members of the pharmacy team will accept patients' temperature and screen for symptoms or illness. Immunization will be delayed if the patient has fever or other symptoms related to the disease until symptoms are resolved, Walgreens said in a statement. CVS expects to manage more than double the amount of flu shots it manages during a typical season, spokesman Matthew Blanchett said in a Mail. Walgreens expects flu demand to increase in the range of 30% to 50%, said Rina Shah, the company's vice president of pharmacy and operations. We're ready it's a requirement, she said in an interview. Patients in both chains will be encouraged, but are not required to pre-receive and process documents, both through each company's app and through the website. They are also required to wear masks during vaccination and while shopping at the store. CVS and Walgreens will also disinfect surfaces between each patient to protect people from COVID-19. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends that people over 6 months of age get a flu shot. Walgreens manages a shot for those over 4. Most insurance plans cover the flu shot for free. Looking ahead to potential COVID-19 vaccines, Shah said Walgreens is also willing to offer them if and when one or more are available.
