Basically six moves to join letters:Short upswing, short upswing over to two on hours, high upswing, short drop, short drop over to two on the clock, see more instructions below. Writing a path to reading a book basically, there are five handwritten strokes to add to handwritten letters. Romalda Spalding has an excellent description in her book on Amazon, Writing a Way to Reading. The entire lesson is only six pages long and can be taught in just a few classes.
