When we first pulled the mattress out of the box, we used a small pair of scissors to remove the plastic film and allow the mattress to turn around on its own. The memory foam is advertised as hypoallergenic and environmentally friendly, but there was still a different new mattress smell for hours. We ended up leaving it in a well-ventilated area for the night so the smell could dissipate before we moved it to our son's room. We found that this is true for all testers in our family- adults and toddlers alike. Casper's mattress consists of four layers of breathable and supportive memory foam. We didn't notice any visible differences in the different areas of the mattress, but we woke up without the stiff joints in the hips or shoulders, so we'd say it works.
