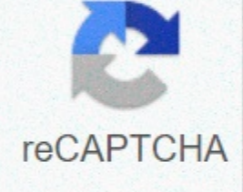

Wear a face mask when visiting our office. The roles and responsibilities of the treasurer are: Collector of real estate and manufactured house taxes. Chief investment officer responsible for managing the province's investment portfolio. Cash manager of the County. The Treasurer's Office keeps daily records of deposits and withdrawals and reconciles bank statements. Is a member of the Investment Advisory Board, Board of Revision, Budget Commission and Microfilming Board. County treasurers in all 88 Ohio counties have traditionally served as the local tax recipient. However, tighter budgets and increasing demands at the local level have changed the face of the position of the province's treasurer and raised expectations for this important occupation. The Treasurer today serves as the county's chief investment officer, the administrator of advanced delinquent tax collection programs and the holder of real estate tax escrow accounts.
