



LA PARVA

La Parva is the smallest and most underrated of the Three Valleys resorts. It offers great access to the Andes backcountry and lots of freeride possibilities; from beginner terrain to challenging couloirs for experts. Keep in mind that snowstorms usually blow in from the West, which is why La Parva often gets less snow than its neighboring valleys Valle Nevado and El Colorado.

Beginner terrain

Within the resort you will find easy and relatively flat freeride terrain, for example in the *Valle de Fabre* area. (1)

Intermediate terrain

The *Agua de las Aguilas* enables access to a huge, south-facing slope. This is the position you are looking for in the search for (intermediate) powder playground.



Expert terrain

A 20-30 minutes hike brings you to the *La Chimenea* (3) (The Chimney) that gives you access to various couloirs.
