The Classification of Classes

LCU classes fall under four “majors” accordingly: (1) Theology, (2) Ministry, (3) Leadership, and (4) Life Skills

Fall 2026 Program Offerings

Classes will be offered in a small group format and may be attended either in person or online via Zoom. All classes will be conducted by an instructor or a facilitator. Some classes will also utilize the RightNow Media video library in combination with moderated group discussions.

LCU will offer credits for all courses. An accumulation of 36 Credits will result in a Certificate of Completion of Ministry at a graduation event. Courses will be offered by semester according to the syllabus below. The following is the Fall 2026 Semester syllabus:

Kingdom Warfare [Theology - 6 Credits]

This will be a required session for all LCU attendees and will utilize Pastor Zamore's book, Kingdom Warfare: Book One. This class will help you gain a scholarly understanding of spiritual strongholds and prepare you to do warfare with demons.

Conflict Resolution in Ministry [Ministry - 1 Credit]

This live class, taught by Deacon Duane Canady, will teach leaders and members alike how to handle ministry conflicts in accordance with church policy and Biblical principles.

Foreign Missions Preparedness [Ministry - 1 Credit]

From travel documents to immunizations to logistics to spiritual preparation for mission trips, Nikisha Roberts and her Missions team will teach you all the intricacies of going on foreign missions. You will see documentation from previous mission trips and be prepared for upcoming trips to The Gambia, Africa and beyond.

How to Attract & Retain Volunteers [Ministry - 1 Credit]

A congregation lives and dies by its team of volunteers. How do you go about recruiting great volunteers and caring for them in a way that they attract others? This class incorporates the RightNow Media video series in which Tim Stevens, who wrote *Simply Strategic Volunteers*, talks about how to build a self-sustaining volunteer development process. Pastor Rennie Rampersad will moderate the class discussion.

Kingdom Enterprise [Life Skills - 1 Credit]

Deacon Patrick Roberts will use the RightNow Media videos (*Marketplace Ministry Masterclass*) of David Balestri to moderate this powerful class that will help transform individuals and the church into prosperous Kingdom citizens.

Re-visioning Small Groups [Ministry - 1 Credit]

Pastor Lennox Zamore and Minister Ralph Alderman will conduct roundtable discussions with small group leaders of Exciting Central to help retool small groups in assisting their cohorts to “Live Christ Together.”

Friendship Evangelism [Ministry - 1 Credit]

Deacon Matt Wilson and Pastor Terry Clark will utilize RightNow Media videos from Jimmy Coggins to teach the principles and practices of evangelizing through authentic friendships. Class participants will put the principles into practice through a required soul winning session.

Lifestyle Evangelism [Ministry - 1 Credit]

Deacon Matt Wilson and Pastor Terry Clark will utilize RightNow Media videos from Jesse Stirnemann to teach participants how to establish a lifestyle of evangelism. Class participants will put the principles into practice through a required soul winning session.

Kingdom Financial Stewardship [Life Skills - 1 Credit]

Deacon Patrick Roberts & Darius Carter will teach Biblical and practical principles on how to manage money, budget resources, grow wealth, practice generosity, and invest in the Kingdom of God.

LCU Panel Discussion and Certificate Ceremony
