Is This Course For You, and Your Work Place?

This qualification is aimed at anyone taking on the role of emergency first aider, in most work places. For lower- to medium-risk work places, this level of training may be sufficient for the organisation's needs*

For those with more in-depth training needs, this course is the first stepping-stone to the full (3-day) qualified First Aider qualification

It meets the HSE statutory criteria for first aid training to "emergency" level.

*Employers should make an assessment of their first aid needs, to determine the appropriate level of training and coverage, according to The Health and Safety (First-Aid) Regulations 1981

The course will introduce delegates to...

- ◆ The roles and responsibilities of a First Aider.
- ◆ Assessing an incident
- ◆ Providing first aid to an unresponsive casualty
- ◆ Providing first aid to a choking casualty
- ◆ Providing first aid to casualty with external bleeding
- ◆ Providing first aid to a casualty who is in shock



Supplementary Information

Guided Learning Hours: Minimum of 7 hours including assessments, delivered in a single days session (09:00-17:00)

Assessment Format: Delegates will need to correctly answer 12 questions, on a multi-choice test of 15 questions. Delegates will also need to correctly demonstrate a variety of techniques to a satisfactory standard.

Candidate Requirements; Level 3 is roughly equivalent to “A” level study. Candidates require good functional skills (specifically English), to complete the multi-choice test and take advantage of the work book and other written materials. Also required is the physical capability to complete the practical activities and assessments; manoeuvring casualties into the recovery position, applying CPR, etc.

No prior experience in first aid is required.
