This wikiHow will teach you how to update the Minecraft version. While Minecraft is usually updated automatically on all platforms, sometimes you can force a blocked update by installing it manually. Keep in mind that to download a Minecraft update you have to be connected to the Internet on the platform to use.

1 Open the Minecraft launcher. Tap or double-click the Minecraft app icon. This is one that looks like a block of grassy mud. The Minecraft version for Windows 10 cannot be manually updated.

2 Log in if necessary. If you are asked to log in to your account, enter your email address and password and click SIGN IN.

3 Look for the Download tag on the PLAY button. If under the text PLAY you see the word Download, and then the version number on the green button at the bottom of the launcher, it means that the update is available for your version of Minecraft. If even if you know that the update is available, you don't see the download tag, skip the next two steps.

4 Tap KNPCA PLAY. This is a green button located at the bottom of the launcher. This will allow you to start downloading the update.

5 Wait until the update completes the download. Once the green bar progresses at the bottom of the launcher disappears, you can start playing Minecraft.

6 Download Minecraft again if necessary. If you can't install the Minecraft update available for your country, try downloading the latest version of the Minecraft installation again. To download it, remove Minecraft from your computer and then follow these steps: Go to and log in if necessary. Click DOWNLOAD in the top left top left to the left of the page. Click the green button that says DOWNLOAD. It's in the middle of the page.

7 Minecraft update to Windows 10. If you have a Windows 10 computer but you're using the Java edition of Minecraft, you can upgrade it for free to Windows 10 by doing the following:

1 Open the App Store of your iPhone. Click on the App Store app icon. This is one that looks like a white A against a celestial background.

2 Click Updates. It is in the bottom right corner of the screen. You'll see a list of apps that need updating.

3 Search Minecraft. Scroll down (if necessary) to find the minecraft app icon and name. If Minecraft doesn't show up here, there are no updates available for the app. If your Minecraft version is out of date, it may be because your iPhone doesn't support the latest version or that unavailable for your country.

4 Click UPDATE. This is to the right of the Minecraft name. This will start updating the app.

5 Wait until the update is finished downloading. Once you see a button that says OPEN next to the name Minecraft, you can start playing a new version of the game.

1 Open the Google Play store. Click on the Play Store app icon. This is one that looks like a colored triangle on a white background.

2 Tap ≡. It's in the top left of the screen. The pop-up menu appears on the left side of the screen.

3 Tap My apps and games. This option is at the top of the pop-up menu.

4 Click on the UPDATES tab. It's in the top left top left of the page of My Apps and Games.

5 Find the Minecraft option. Scroll down (if necessary) until you find the name and icon of the Minecraft app. If you can't find an option called Minecraft, there are no updates available. If your Minecraft version is out of date, it may be because your Android does not support the latest version or that the version is not available for your country.

6 Click UPDATE. This is to the right of the Minecraft name. This will start updating the app.

7 Wait until the update is finished downloading. Once you see a button that says OPEN to the right of the Minecraft title, you can start playing a new version of the game.

1 Open my apps and games. This option is located on the Xbox One dashboard.

2 Choose games. It is in the top left corner of the screen.

3 Choose Minecraft. Scroll across the game until you find the name Minecraft and then select it.

4 Click ≡. To the right of the Guide button on the Xbox One controller. The menu appears.

5 Choose to manage games and add-ons. This is one of the menu options. This will open the game page.

6 Select the Update tab. He's in the panel on the left side.

7 Select Update. If the update doesn't start downloading automatically, select it and click A to start downloading. If you don't see any updates here, it means that Minecraft has already been upgraded to the latest version available for your country.

8 Follow the instructions on the screen. If you're asked to confirm an update or choose where to install it, do so. Once the update is complete, you'll be able to play Minecraft normally.

1 Choose Minecraft. Open the game library (or look for Minecraft on the dashboard) and then scroll to select the game.

5 Wait until the update completes the download. This can take anywhere from a few minutes to several hours. Once you see the Ready-to-See message under the update, you'll be able to continue.

6 Install an update. Choose an update, click X, and then click X again when the menu appears to drop out. The update will start to be installed on the PS4 hard drive. You don't need to do anything while installing the update, but if any sign appears on the screen, follow it.

1 Choose Minecraft. Go to the homepage and then scroll to select Minecraft. In order to follow these steps, the Minecraft cartridge must be inserted into your Nintendo switch.

2 Open the Options page. When choosing Minecraft, open the Options page by clicking the I or .

3 Choose a software update. It's on the Options menu.

4 Choose over the Internet. This option will appear in the pop-up. Choosing it will start the Minecraft update.

5 Follow the instructions on the screen. If you're asked for permission or notified that more updates are available, follow the instructions as needed.
