

# A Time to Stop and Wait

"Look, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel," which means, "God is with us." ~ Matthew 1:23

Our 5th grandchild was born on October 6. Elodie Marie, 8 pounds 1 ounce, 19.5 inches long. We were so excited to meet her! On a Sunday afternoon we rushed through lunch, loaded our bags in the car and made the  $3 \frac{1}{2}$  hour drive to see this beautiful little girl.

She was even more beautiful in person! On the last day of our visit, we were trying really hard to get a nice family picture. Our son was trying to balance the camera on the windowsill and set the timer while we were herding all the kids onto the couch and onto laps and trying to fit everyone in the picture, and Elodie was not happy. She cried through the whole ordeal, probably feeling the stress of all the activity and movement and noise around her.

Once it was over, the crying baby became my responsibility. I was using everything I knew to comfort her. I was bouncing and swaying and singing, but nothing was working. As she moved from crying to hyperventilating, I tried one more thing, more out of surrender than brilliance. I stopped. I stopped bouncing. I stopped swaying. I stopped singing. I stopped everything... and just held her. It was almost instantaneous. She stopped crying, gave me one last look, closed her eyes and fell asleep.

Advent is supposed to be like that. It's supposed to be a time of stopping. Unfortunately, it can be a time of overwhelming activity, stress and noise that overruns any sense of the sacred our hearts long for. Advent invites us to stop, take a moment and breathe deeply. We have arrived once more at the beginning of the Christian story. A time of waiting and setting apart time from the busy-ness of the season for connection with the One who has come in the past, will come in the future, and comes into our present.

God is already holding us. This is a time to realize it and lean into the hope, peace, joy and love that comes in the person of Jesus Christ, the Son of God, Emmanuel.

"O come, let us adore Him."


