PolyMatrix Powder can be combined with commonly used Active Pharmaceutical Ingredients (APIs), such as antibiotics and analgesics. PolyMatrix Powder, when mixed with an API, is anhydrous and therefore, a beyond-use-date (BUD) of up to 90 days can be given, based on USP <795>.1

TCA 0.11%, Lidocaine HCl 1% in PolyMatrix Powder

Diphenhydramine HCI 2% in PolyMatrix Powder

Metronidazole 2%, Phenytoin 5% in PolyMatrix Powder
