for hearts struggling in the fog of aimlessness.


She gives no thought to the way of life; her paths wander aimlessly, but she does not know it.

if your outlook seems full of broken dreams.



if feeling tossed around in the muck and the mire.



Draw near to God and he will draw near to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. James 4:8




when its hard to envision a future.



For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. 1 Corinthians 5:18




and His way is both straight and narrow.

taking our sins as far as the east is to the west.




