08:00 – Hotel Pick-up / Meet at Materuni Village

Your adventure begins with a scenic drive from Moshi through the lush foothills of Mount Kilimanjaro. Along the way, enjoy panoramic views of coffee plantations, banana farms, and traditional Chagga villages.

08:45 – Arrival & Welcome

Upon arrival, meet your local guide for a short introduction to Materuni Village, its history, Chagga traditions, and the day's activities.

09:00 – Guided Hike to Materuni Waterfalls

- Indigenous medicinal plants
- Local farming practices
- Wildlife and birdlife

The walk takes approximately **40–50 minutes** each way.

09:45 – Explore Materuni Waterfalls

Arrive at the magnificent **80-meter Materuni Waterfall**, one of the tallest waterfalls on the slopes of Mount Kilimanjaro. Enjoy:

- Free time for photography
- Relaxing in the cool mountain mist
- Optional swim in the natural pool
- Scenic nature appreciation

10:30 – Return Walk to Migombani Organic Coffee Farm

Walk back through the village to the beautiful Migombani Coffee Experience overlooking the lush valleys of Materuni.

11:00 – Migombani Organic Coffee Experience

Discover the complete journey of Tanzania's famous Arabica coffee—from bean to cup.

Interactive Activities

- Visit an organic coffee plantation
- Learn coffee harvesting techniques
- Pulp fresh coffee cherries
- Roast beans over a traditional fire
- Grind coffee using a wooden mortar and pestle
- Participate in lively Chagga songs and dances
- Brew and taste your own fresh organic coffee

- Google Maps may sometimes direct drivers onto unsuitable rural roads.
- You may meet local people offering directions; their assistance is voluntary. Accept it only if you choose and at your own discretion.
- Drive carefully, especially during the rainy season, and contact us if you need assistance finding the village.
