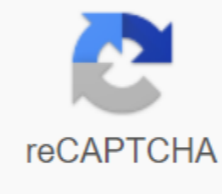

Peregrine class attack fighter

The Peregrine-class light strike ship (also known as the Federation Attack Fighter) is a small, 2nd warp capable of using a shuttle optimized for combat operations. It is commonly used to support fleet action, and can be carried on board any spaceship with sufficient hangar space. Although Starfleet Fields is not dedicated to the ship carrier, Akira-class cruisers, with their large hangar bays, are often the platform of choice for long-distance transport peregrines. The light attack craft is adapted from the Peregrine-class Courier, a concept adopted from the Maki at the beginning of the Dominion war. Maquis originally adapted the easily accessible courier vessel to carry a single Type VIII phaser, but Starfleet expanded the concept by decorating photon torpedoes in addition to the phaser and increasing the power of the deflector shield, SIF and IDF. The Peregrines proved their worth in the Dominion War, flying escort missions in the Navy, protecting the fleet from Hideski-class Cardassian ships and Jem'Hadar fighters. Before the Dominion War, where Starfleet encountered a large number of small enemy expendable ships, the Federation never pursued the concept of a fighter. Following the success of the modified Peregrines, StarFleet is currently considering designs for a special fighter-type spacecraft. Peregrine's class is produced by the same shipbuilding consortium as the larger Ju'Day class, for which it sometimes errs on visual ranges. The Peregrine-class light impact ship consists of two people, a flight and operations manager. The small cabin is similar to the type 15 shuttle cabin, and the cabin cabin behind the cockpit allows the crew to hot bed-bank on long-haul missions. Unlike naval fighter jets in the 20th century, Peregrines is not an aircraft carrier, but accompanies the fleet as independent ships organized in attack squadrons. They are, however, capable of landing on a planetary surface or in a bay hangar, folding wings, allowing belly pads to connect to the deck, and are usually transported to fleet staging areas aboard large starships to prevent crew fatigue and minimize wear on their disk systems. The Federation Attack Fighter was a type of small Federation starship used by Starfleet as an attack fighter during the Dominion War. (DS9: The Donation of Angels) The contents of the story, originally designated as support couriers, these ships were first used in the battle of the Poppies as attack fighters during their uprising against the Cardassian Union. In 2370, a pair of such ships were modernized, armed and used by former Starfleet officer, Lieutenant Commander Calvin Hudson, in an attempt to attack a Cardassian weapons depot on Brime, beginning a poppy uprising. They were busy with Benjamin Sisko at the USS Rio Grande forcing them into a strategic retreat. (DS9: Maki, Part II; TNG: Pre-emptive Strike) Fighters attacking the Dominion Fleet during Operation Return A large number of fighters were used by Starfleet in the Dominion War. During Operation Return, eight successive waves of fighters were sent to attack cardassian Dominion Navy ships, hoping to provoke them to destroy the formation and create an opening for the Federation fleet. (DS9: Donation of Angels) This type of ship was also used by the Flight Coach Academy of the Star View Academy. (VOY: Drone, Voyager Conspiracy, Lifeline) Tactical Systems Shooting Pigorian Pulse Guns Although not originally designed for combat, the ship that became known as the Fighter Attack was capable of being modified to carry an impressive arsenal. Designed for a civilian role, and the size is similar to the Starfleet boat, the original design was only lightly armed, primarily designed for personnel and freight traffic. When using poppies, the militants were armed with any weapon. The first samples of ships used by the poppies were armed with pygorian weapons, including photon torpedoes, pulse cannons, ship's high-energy destroyers and particle accelerators; they were used in a planned attack on a weapons depot in the colony of Bryma. (DS9: Maki, Part II) Captain Keogh called these vessels light armed shuttles, compared to the Dominion ships he expected to encounter in the same year. (DS9: Jem'Hadar) Later, in 2370, another set of ships, according to Gul Evek, was armed with photon torpedoes and type 8 phasers purchased from an unknown source. (TNG: Pre-emptive strike) When using Starfleet since 2374, the ship has been equipped with several modern torpedo launchers and at least one phaser bank with two forward emitters. (DS9: Donation of Angels) Ship Class Appendices The appearance of fighter cockpit interior is re-unchanged as type 18 shuttle cockpits in Search, Part I, Search, Part II and Destiny Fighter Cabin Interior, seen in Maki, Part II, was a modification 15 shuttle set. It was reused later from DS9: Search, Search, I further represent the type 18 cockpit shuttle. In the Maki, Part II scenario, phasers used by the Maki fighter attack are identified as pulsed cannons mentioned earlier in the dialogue. The initial phaser explosions in the episode, however, seem to be a regular phaser of fire from an extended jar under the ship's nose. Photon torpedoes saw a shot from a tube into the bow of the ship. When the torpedoes are damaged, the fighter opens fire with pulsed cannon phasers of two wing mounted jars that are not visible on the model. Shooting type 8 phasers from nacelle installed cans of Visual Effects in a pre-emptive kick show phaser pulses of fire from the wings, where there are three visible pipes on each wing. Phaser Fire was also seen coming from the front ends of the built-in warp nacelles. These banks seem to be targeted, instead of firing straight forward, like the Pigorian Pulse Guns in Macy's, Part II. The Sacrifice of Angels scenario states that attacking fighters fired a barrage of quantum torpedoes when attacking the Dominion line. The effects used for phasers and quantum torpedoes of fighter jets in this episode were not what is commonly associated with this Star-Spny weapon. The torpedoes were mounted on the wings and on the nose of the ship. In some footage, the wing torpedoes seem to be launched from the same location where the pulsed cannons were located in Maki, Part II. In others, they seem to be made of three small visible pipes on each of the wings. These tubes are seemingly too small to launch full-size torpedoes. In one of the shots from the Sacrifice of Angels, one of the fighters shoots a bluish-white beam from one of the two forward phaser emitters, on an extended phaser bank, under the nose of the ship. When the fighter fired the phaser from the same spot in What You Leave Behind, the regular StarFlight phaser effect was used. For information about the studio model, see here. Apocryff According to Star Trek Online, the peregrine-class mentioned, but not seen, in DS9: Heart of Stone was a class name for this type of ship. According to the original Starship collection, the fighter is 25 meters long and has 2 pilots. It is capable of straining 9. External Communication Federation Fighter on Memory Beta, Wiki for Licensed Star Trek Works Peregrine Class was a type of courier ship assigned to poppies, in the early 2370s. In some cases, the Maki modified these courier vessels to specifications comparable to the interceptor, including improved engine capabilities and light weapons. These vessels were widely used during their rebellion against the Cardassian Union. In 2371, Kira Neris and Odo pursued a modified Peregrine-class courier in Badlands after he attacked a Lissep supply ship near the Prophet's Landing. (DS9: Heart The Background Information App Designation Peregrine-Class was only mentioned in the Heart of Stone, where the design is not seen. Roman quarantine equates the ship to the Maki fighter or the Maki raider. Star Trek Online defines this as a class designation of the Federation fighter attack. The fact that the vessel has been named as a former courier of a modified poppy vessel will support the association. The Peregrine-Class (also known as the Federation Fighter) was a type of shuttle and fighter used by the Federation. The Maki assigned several of these ships and used them as fighters during their uprising against the Cardassian Union. Starfleet used them during the Dominion War. During Operation Return, several waves of fighter jets were sent to attack the Cardassian ships of the Dominion Fleet. It was hoped that they would infuriate the Cardassians enough to break the formation, knowing that the Jem'Hadar would not flinch, and would follow the fighters, thereby opening a hole in their lines. (DS9: Donation of Angels) Individually these fighters do not pose a great threat to starships and therefore usually operate in groups. To facilitate this, they were often deployed on a ship with large shuttles such as the Akira Class and the Eldorado Class. (LUG RPG: Dominion of War Source: Armageddon Fires) StarFleet: Generation Of The Fleet (edited by editing source) By 2381, the Peregrine class was decommissioned and replaced by the Shadow Class. Star Trek: The New Order (edited by editing source) By the 2380s, a new version of Strike Fighter Peregrine was developed. This option features a two-seater cockpit in standard as well as improved weapons and sensors, as well as a much more powerful pulse engine. These modifications ensure that the Peregrine fighter remains the Federation's premier strike fighter, as well as in the 2390s and beyond.
