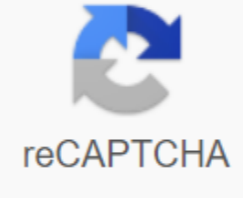




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Short maid of honor speech examples

Unless you want to lose your friendship. Especially women take the honor of being chosen as a bridesmaid or, more importantly, bridesmaids or matrons of honor as a serious thing. It means you're their best friend, and they're your most important friend. You're announcing it publicly. But what do you do when something happens during wedding planning to get you to change your mind about who you want to stand next to you at the altar when you take your vows? Especially if many of your wedding guests know the gossip. Sometimes a demotion is worse than just asking her to justify herself from a wedding altogether. Recently I had a bride tell me that her MH (the only member of her wedding) refuses to show her the bridesmaid dress she purchased. She told her in a rather nasty email that since she had not received the privilege of helping choose the bride's wedding dress, the bride had no right to see her dress. It's so wrong. When the bride contacted me upset, I invited her to sit face to face and find out what was going on in the head of the MH. If there is a problem, it must be solved. And in this case, the wedding was less than a month away. Your wedding day is about you and your fiance and no one else, honestly. Yes, you want your family to be happy with your decisions and you want your wedding to have fun. But if your MH has officially identified yourself as a maid of dishonor, you should back up and rethink things. This will have consequences for your friendship. But wouldn't there be consequences if she was a jerk on your big day?
