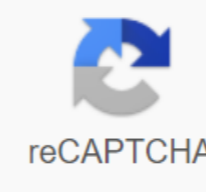

Scholarships are awesome resources if you check out different ways to pay for college. It's free money after all - what's not to love? As it turns out, most scholarship programs have application processes that are not exactly attractive. Students usually have to provide a lot of information about themselves: transcripts, GPAs, test scores, resumes, community service activities, and so on. There may even be a few essays and classes of requirements thrown out as well. You don't want to complain because, again, free money, but these apps are sure to be tiring when you work on college applications, high school courses, and financial aid applications all at the same time. The following light scholarships have application processes that are more manageable. Some ask you to write short essays, while others do not require essays at all. The rewards may not be as big as some of the other scholarships out there, but when the application process is so easy, you really don't have much to lose. I'll start with some words of warning before I get into the good stuff: essays and non-essay scholarships that are so easy to apply for, you may end up applying to all of them! Caveat: If the scholarship seems too good to be true... Unfortunately, there aren't too many legitimate light scholarships out there. If a scholarship application sounds too good to be true, be careful you don't want to fall victim to a scholarship scam! Here are some things to look out for: a scholarship app that requests personal information that is not relevant to the award: Many leading scholarship programs request personal information (transcripts, SAT/ACT assessments, and even financial information for needy scholarships); however, this information is relevant to the candidate's assessment. If you're ever uncomfortable providing personal information for a scholarship program, dig deeper. Can you verify that the program is legitimate? Does it have its own website, or can you find information about it only through a third party? Try the Googling (reward name) scam to see if there is anything suspicious that pops up. A scholarship that asks you to make payments to enter or win: Scholarship programs are in the business of giving money to students rather than accepting it. The scholarship program is likely just a scam if the app asks you to make a payment, especially if it asks you to enter credit card information. Now that we have that aside, it's time to get to the good things: all the best easy essays and non-essay scholarships and how to win them! These essays won't take you long at all, but they're a good excuse to create in your favorite coffee shop. Essay Scholarship Scholarships in this section ask students to submit short essays with their applications. Even if you have to write an essay, the rest of the application (and the essay itself) should be easy and manageable for all these awards. In fact, most of these applications should not take more than one or two hours. Bachus and Schanker LLC Scholarship This scholarship program is slightly different from most of the other awards included in this post-it funded private law firm in Colorado. Students compete for a \$2,000 reward by writing an essay (at least 800 words) about the 7th Amendment and how it affects their lives. Right: High school students who have been accepted into four-year university and university students with a minimum of 3.0 GPA Term: November 30, 2020 (to win a scholarship for the spring semester) and July 30, 2021 (to win a scholarship for the fall semester). Courage to Grow Scholarship This \$500 award is awarded to one lucky student Month. To compete for the award, applicants must explain in 250 words why they are they deserve a scholarship. Right: U.S. High School Juniors and Seniors and College Students with a Minimum 2.5 GPA Term: Last Day of Each Month! Odenza Marketing Group Scholarship To compete for this \$500 award, applicants must like the Odenza Facebook page and write two short essays of about 500 words each. One essay should be related to travel and your career, and another should explain why you should get a scholarship. Right: Current high school students ages 16-25 or students who have at least one year of college remaining. Applicants must also have a minimum of 2.5 GPAs. The deadline is March 30, 2021 MoneySolver.org Scholarships (TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED) NOTE: All MoneySolver scholarships have been temporarily suspended as a result of the coronavirus pandemic. They hope to resume accepting applications in 2021. Web MoneySolver.org issues several \$1,000 scholarships throughout the year for American students enrolled in (or planning to enroll next fall in) college, university, or trade school. Each of these scholarships includes writing a short (250 words, maximum) essay on the subject. Students are eligible to win up to two scholarships. Some of these apps won't take you longer than a few minutes. No-Essay Scholarships When it comes to light applications, you can't get much easier than following a scholarship program. You will still have to submit some information about yourself (and in some cases, complete some brief activities or tasks), but you don't have to write any essays to qualify. AFSA High School Scholarship for this scholarship, all you have to do is fill out an entry form and answer eight quiz questions. Ten \$2,000 awards will be given each year. Winners are randomly selected using a computer drawing. Right: Current High School Students (U.S. Citizens or Legal Residents) Deadline: Applications accepted between September 1, 2020 and April 1, 2021 Dr. Pepper Training Giveaway Students can claim to win \$2,500, \$20,000, or even \$100,000 in tuition money by writing a brief description of how they plan to change the world and explaining the video recording of their academic and professional goals. No Essay College Scholarship Is a \$2,000 award awarded monthly. To apply for this scholarship, apply, which includes basic identification information, your GPA, and your SAT ACT scores. Winners are selected randomly and you can apply every month. Right: High school students, high school students, Heading back to school, current college students, and anyone else looking to attend college or graduate school during the next year's Deadline: The Last Day of Each Month! Right: High school students in the U.S. and Canada (except for some states and territories - invoke official rules for details) Deadline: The presentation window is likely to be between April and June 2021: Voting will take place in June-July 2021, the U.S. Bank Student Union Scholarship Three \$5,000 award, one \$10,000 award, and one \$20,000 award available through this scholarship program. Since these scholarship applications are so easy to complete, you will probably have a lot of competition. Here are some strategies that will help you present your best applications possible: #1: If you have to write an essay, you will probably be more successful if your views are consistent with those of the person who awards the scholarship. To prepare, do some research about the company or charity mission statement. #2: Make sure your app is polished. You won't be able to more than the first impression (remember, these apps are short and sweet!), so double-check for any grammar, spelling or punctuation errors. #3: Last but not least, make sure your application is completed and on What's next? These scholarships are great options if you want to shoot down as many applications as possible. As you may have already noticed, however, the rewards amounts are a little underwhelming (although keep in mind that a few small rewards can be just as useful as one big award!). Large scholarships and grants are often available through colleges directly and applying for financial assistance through FAFSA.
