Sophie is due to complete her curacy at St Philips at Easter 2022, when she hopes to increase her hours as Cambridge's Chaplain to Homeless People. The purpose of the service is to publicly acknowledge to the wider homeless sector that Sophie is taking over the reins from Jon and to invite people to support this transition. People from the street-life and homeless community and representatives from the homeless sector will be present. All are welcome to attend this short and informal service and to stay for refreshments afterwards.
