

## 'What Matters?' Educator Programme FAQs

### 1. What modules can I take?

Our modules are released monthly. Each are designed to be between 90 and 180 minutes long, with accompanying elective 'mini-modules'.

1. Towards Sustainable and Circular Futures - Access from 19th Oct, 2020
2. Owning your Wellbeing - Access from 19th Nov, 2020
3. Creativity and the Curriculum - Access from 1st Dec, 2020
4. Learn to Collaborate, Collaborate to Learn - Access from 1st Jan, 2021
5. *What Matters?* A Consolidation Module - Access from 1st Feb, 2021

### 2. How much is the 'What Matters?' Educator Programme?

We have several pricing packages for individuals and organisations, wishing to complete Phase 1 of the 'What Matters?' Programme. See the below box:

Completion of min. 3 modules achieves an invitation to the Spring onsite programme (Phase 2) and the follow-on Phases 3-4. This section of the programme costs £250 per participant (excluding accommodation). See below for what this includes:

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## Phase 2 - 4: Explore, Materialise & Reflect. Onsite Programme Spring - Summer 2021

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### Access to a two day programme including

- Journey mapping
- Practical activities building on the Core Four online modules
- Workshops on storytelling, outdoor learning, developing personal reflection skills, coastal foraging, Design Thinking and curriculum design
- Well-being provision including Somatic coaching, breath work, Yoga and journaling
- Collaborative design of personalised Action-Impact Projects
- Thinking Time
- Networking with peers and leading practitioners
- All meals, snacks and resources

### Access to Phase 3-4 support

- Cymbrogi supported implementation of Action-Impact projects
- Ongoing online support
- Reflection and multiplier opportunities
- Graduation and certification

**Cost:** £250 per participant (*this does not include accommodation, additionally priced between £20-£75 per night*)

**Note:** *The above prices reflect a 50% discount on Autumn 2021- Summer 2022 prices.*

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### 3. How many modules do I need to take to be eligible for the Spring onsite programme?

Completion of 3 modules gains an invitation to the Spring onsite experience. Though, we recommend you complete all 5 modules and as many electives as possible. This will lay the knowledge foundations for you to make the most of the onsite programme.

### 4. Will there be any COVID-19 safety measures?

Yes. We have been working hard behind the scenes to ensure we can adhere to government-recommended COVID-19 measures. This includes:

- Limited number of people in onsite learning groups (max. 6, but may change subject to government advice)
- 2-metre social distancing at all times
- Mostly outdoors learning (weather permitting)
- We ask that face masks or coverings are worn when indoors
- Thorough sanitisation of communal areas and accommodation
- Hand sanitiser can be found throughout the site

### 5. How do I navigate the module?


You can either complete the module in one go, or complete a sub-section (component) at a time.

Navigate through the slides using the '>' icon.

If you choose to complete a component (or a few) at a time, you have two options to locate the component(s) you would like to complete:

1. Either scroll down the webpage and stop at the component you'd like to complete. Then, navigate through the slides using the '>' icon.

2. Use the slider menu at the top of the page to find the component you would like to complete. Click 'Go there' and you will be taken straight to your desired component. Then, navigate through the slides using the '>' icon.



6. When I press 'play' the slides seem to jump around.

We recommend you navigate through the slides using the '>' icon.

Listen to the recording, complete the activities and move on to the next slide using the '>' button.




Pressing the video directly or anywhere else on screen or page may cause it to jump.

7. What is the 'Collaboration Space' and how do I use it?

The Collaboration Space is a private group (only for the use of those enrolled on the module) on our Cymbrogi Futures Network. It is a space where you can ask any questions you may have about the content. Your questions will either be answered by the Module Lead and Facilitators (and discussed in our monthly Q&As), or by one of your fellow Cymbrogi Companions.

Please feel free to use this space to discuss anything around the module – you can answer your peers' questions; add to discussion threads; or create your own discussion. It is a space where you can share resources, lesson ideas and experiences
