The Carebidet is a revolutionary Complete Intelligent (and Automated) Toileting System (CITS) for incontinent, bedridden, or mobility-challenged individuals that delivers smarter care and better health outcomes



Where is it neded?

Anyone caring for incontinent, bedridden or mobility challenged patients. Comfortable, cost-effective, and easy-to-use, the Carebidet decreases the burden on caregivers, healthcare costs, CO2, waste, paper diapers, odor, worries, stress, and delay.

A 3-year study replacing adult diaper care with use of a Carebidet showed a **63% time-savings, and a 54% reduction in cumulative care burden** if replacing the medically recommended 8 changes per day with the Carebidet.

It has also been confirmed that the use of a Carebidet robot

for fecal and urinary incontinence care is effective in **reducing the incidence**

of incontinence associated dermatitis, pressure, ulcer risk, decreased lymphocytes, improved serum albumin levels and improving physiological indicators in critically ill patients.

Utilizing a Carebidet can contribute to economical toileting care, enhance the standard of care, and promote better patient outcomes and comfort. Simultaneously, it enhances caregiver efficiency, leading to decreased stress and heightened job satisfaction.

Significant technological innovations of the CITS include the 5 different and automated functions that it performs: detection, removal of waste, washing, drying, and ongoing moisture management.

When the advanced, built-in sensors detect urine and/or feces, it is automatically 'flushed' away, removing both solid and liquid waste immediately upon excretion, **virtually eliminating skin exposure** in the pelvic girdle/sacrum. Additionally, Carebidet then cleans/washes and dries the area automatically. Also, initiating a drying cycle every hour (or as scheduled) to ensure a dry perineum area for the patient.

This ergonomically designed bidet was **created for people** with limited mobility, such as the elderly, disabled, or patients restricted to bed and those with incontinence. This is a segment of society with a shortage of caregivers which creates a significant challenge.
