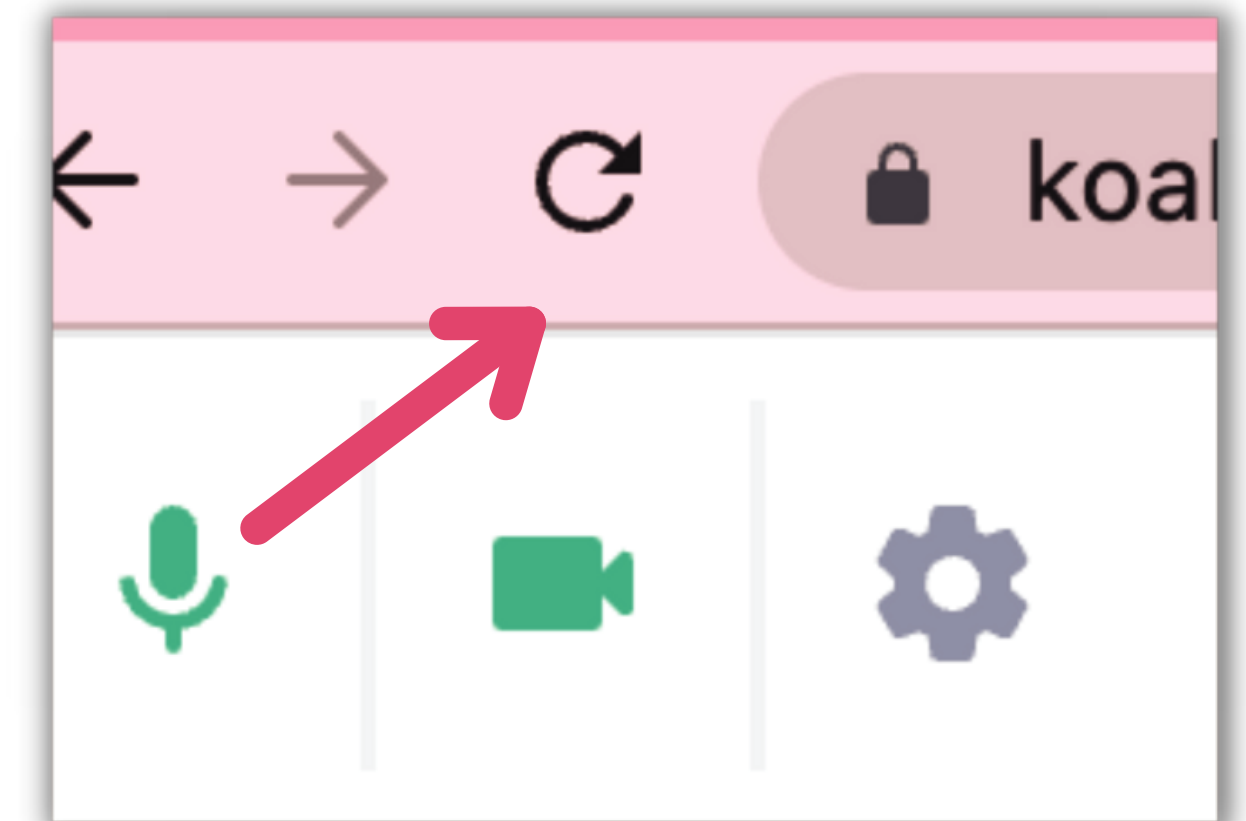
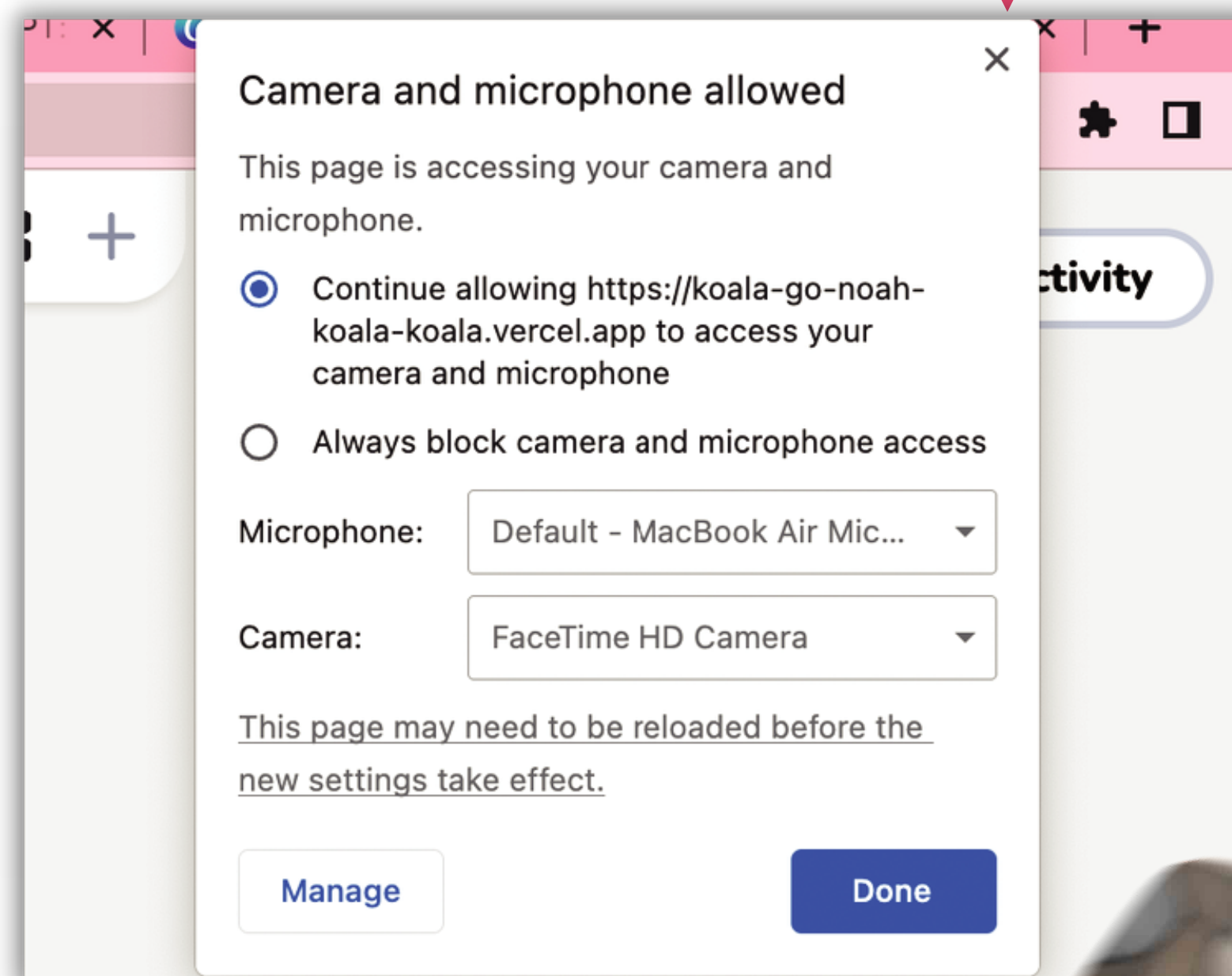


How to allow Microphone and Camera permission in Koala Go



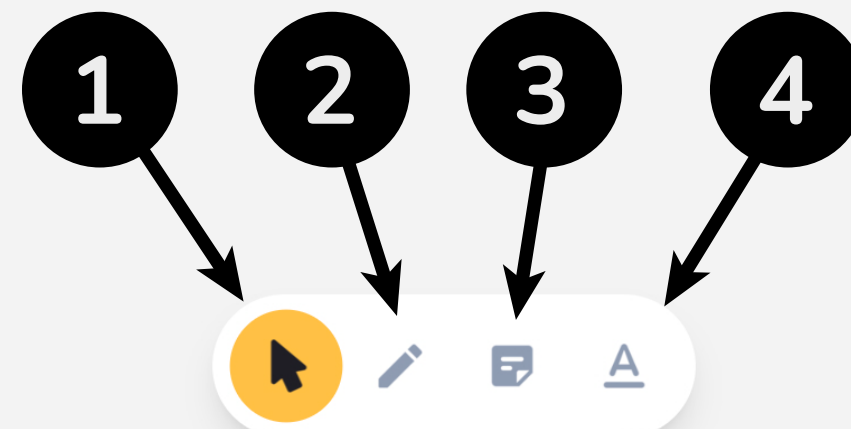
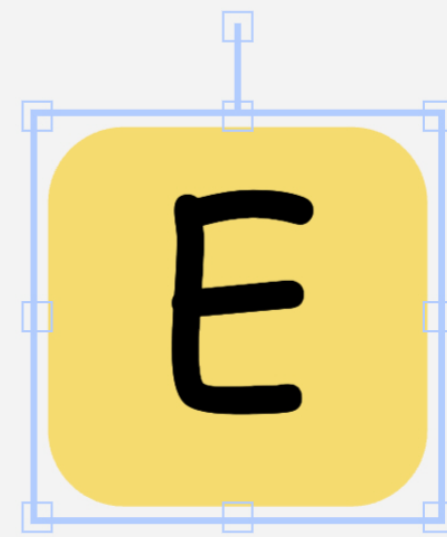
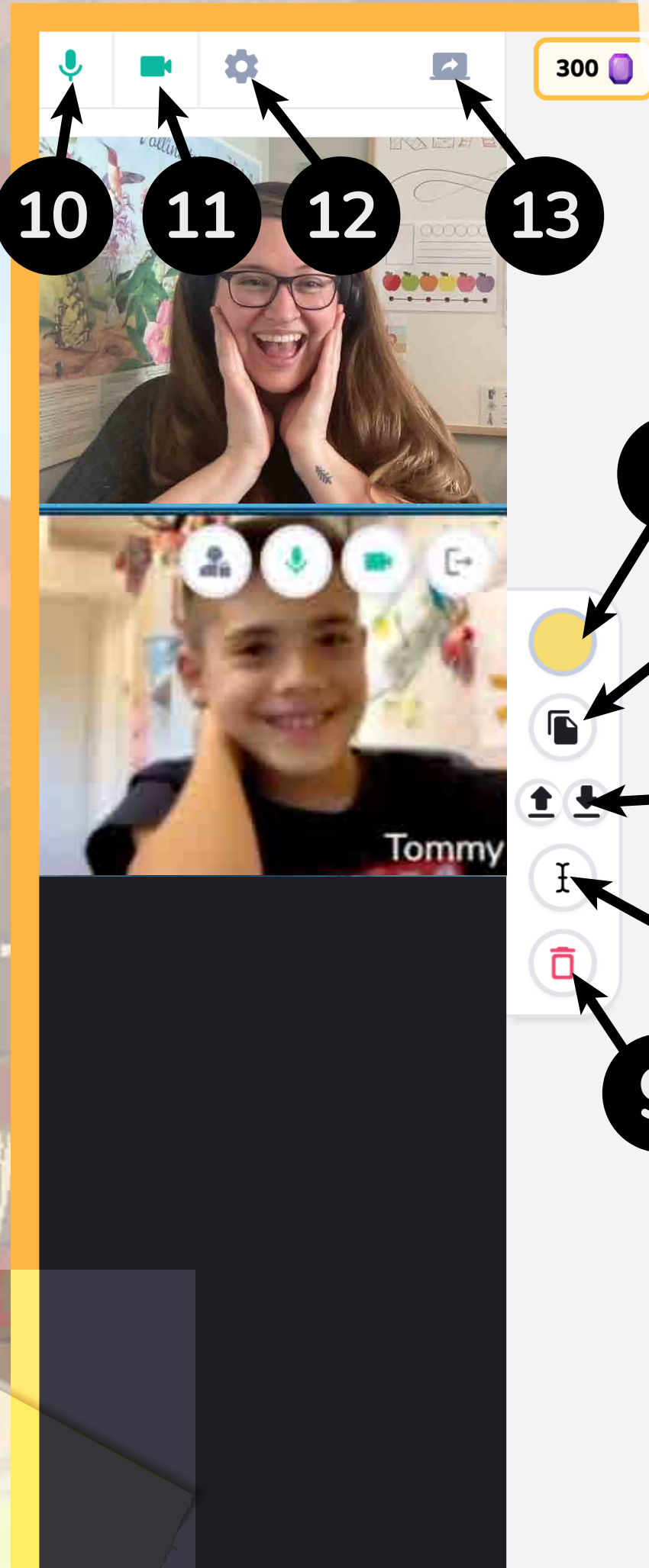
Step 1: Click on this camera icon that you'll see on the upper part of your screen





Step 2: Make sure to give access to Koala Go for cam & mic





Step 3: Refresh your browser page by clicking the arrow sign on the left part of your screen

1.  **Cursor:** Move a text, photo, or item around the classroom by clicking the first icon shown in the photo above.
2.  **Pencil:** You know what to do! Write and draw whatever you like.
3.  **Sticky notes:** Insert small messages or important reminders on the whiteboard anywhere you like. It's great for single letters, single words, or numbers.
4.  **Text box:** Too tired to use the pencil to write? You can always use this to type sentences and words.

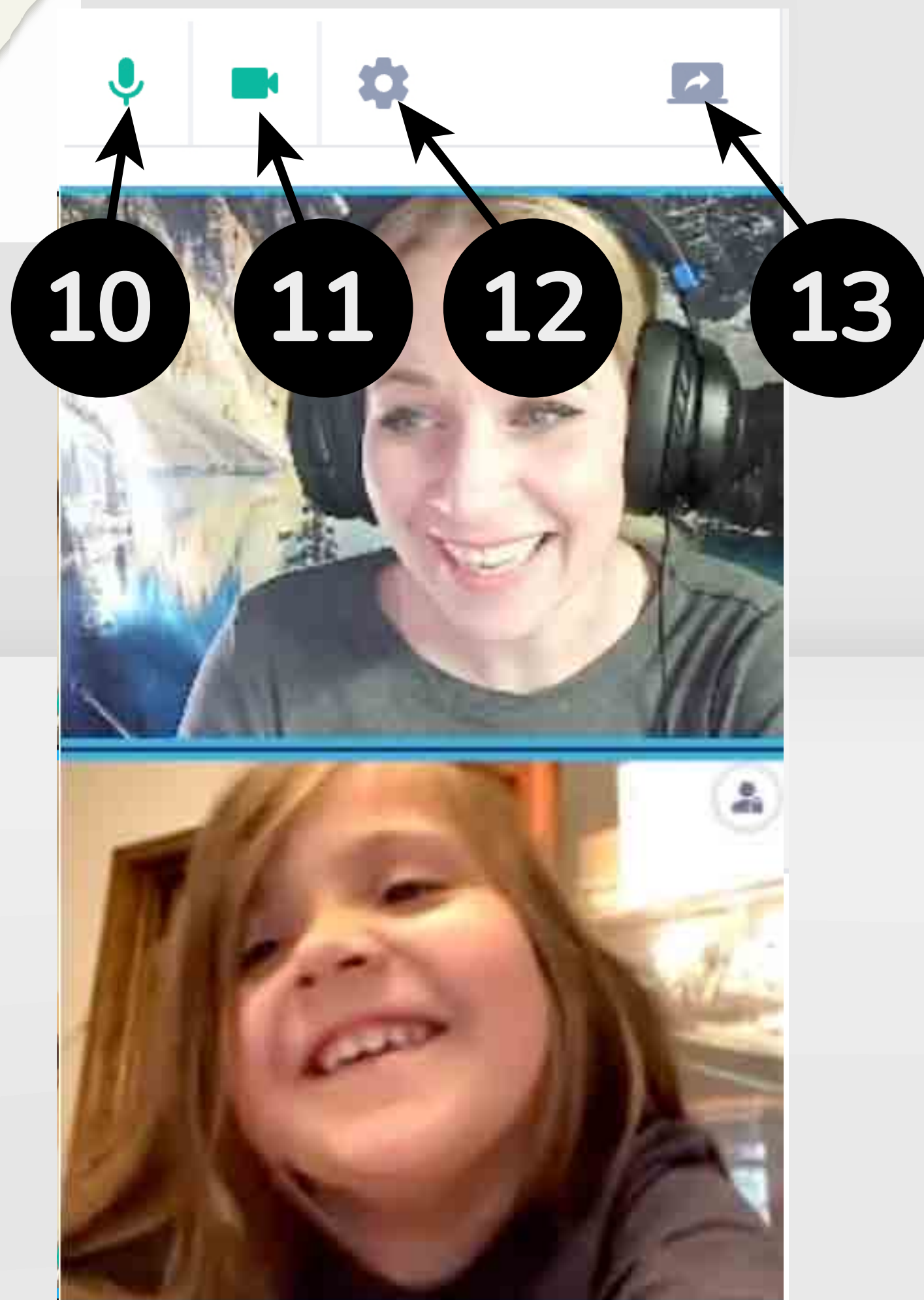
5.  **Color Palette:** This is where you can choose your preferred color for your sticky notes and pencil.

6.  **Duplicate:** You'll be able to replicate anything you place on your activity board with this tool.

7.  **Bring to Front:** Puts an element on the activity board in front or overlaps another element.
Send to Back: Sends an element on the activity board behind another element.

8.  **Edit:** Using this tool, you can add or edit text on your activity board.

9.  **Delete:** Remove unwanted items on your whiteboard.



10. **Microphone:** When your microphone turns green, it means that it is on.







11. **Camera:** Turn on your camera by clicking on its icon.







12. **Devices:** This will help you check out your microphone and camera settings.

13. **Share Screen:** Click on this so your teacher can see your screen! (This feature is only available on PC/Mac)

1.  **Pencil Tool:** Draw anything you wish using our pencil tool!
2.  **Toggle View:** Gives you the ability to see the playground from your avatar's perspective
3.  **Avatar Customization:** Changing your avatar's clothing, hair, eyes, etc which will be found when you click on the button found on the center bottom of your screen. What's great about this is your student may also customize their own avatar!
4.  This will allow your avatar to **jump** to high places (you may also use the **space bar** on your keyboard to jump!)
5.  Add blocks, objects, or sticky notes. Purchase your furniture using gems!
6.  Click on this **shovel icon** to remove specific building blocks.

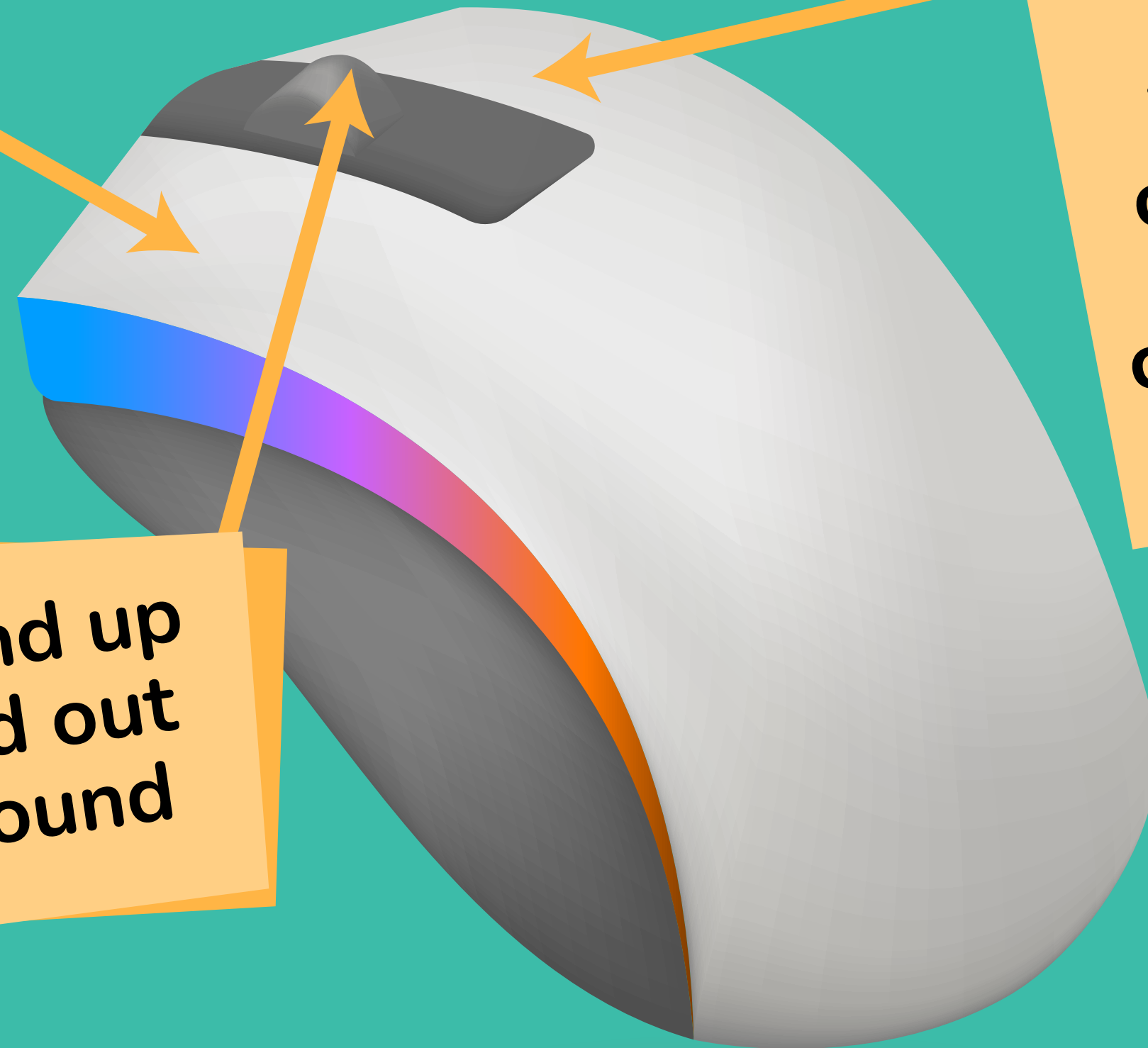
How to control your Avatar

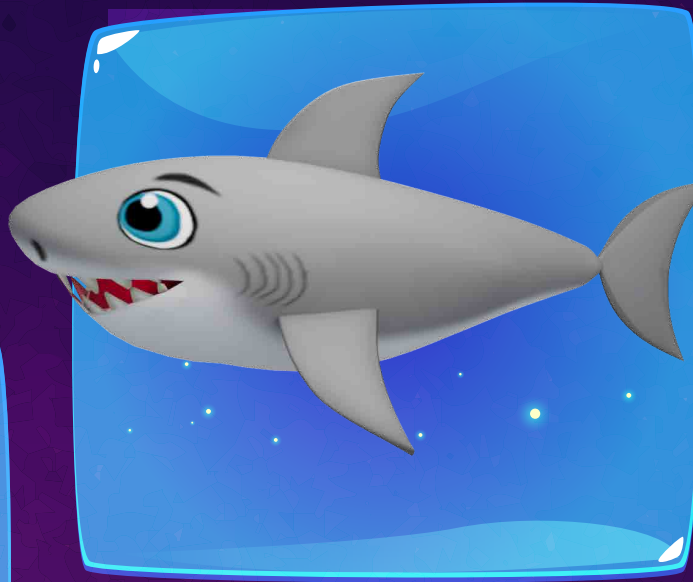
using your Mouse
