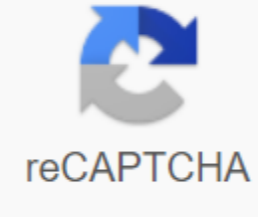

Having successfully recovered from the near-fatal shooting at the end of Legend Part 2 (episode), NCIS Special Agent G. As Cullen returned, the OSP team investigated the assassination of the Navy commander, was kidnapped by a drug cartel and eventually killed shootout between the cartel and lap members of the Los Angeles Police Department. The OSP team investigates a raid on a house owned by a drug dealer that a group of cats carried out with the case soon becomes very personal to Sam, as a group of people he originally trained. This seems to be a simple case, but the team will soon discover that the double intersection that occurred in the house can run much deeper than originally thought, and that it may even be attended by a member of the Los Angeles Police Department, who may also be a dirty cop. It was the

While on his jetski, a man who hails from North Korea shot dead, and the OSP team fear that the victim's secret secrets may have been lost, but everything changes when the team discover the suspect: a North Korean killer, Lee Wuan Kai, who appears to have a story with NCIS Director Leon Vance. As Los Angeles prepares to celebrate Christmas, the OSP is investigating when a Marine is killed through his cellphone that explodes, and an investigation leads them to a disfigured serviceman who may be the killer, but none of this is what it seems. 11 11 Violation (episode) January 5, 2010. The OSP is investigating when a petty officer dies when a stolen car he was in crashes into a strip club. During this case, the team discover a plot to extort intelligence secrets from various male Navy personnel while the terrorist targets vulnerable young men to fight his Holy War and one of his goals is Sam's friend. 12 12 Past Lives (episode) January 12, 2010. The sailor is executed in broad daylight, prompting the OSP team to investigate the circumstances of the murder, while Cullen goes undercover as one of his old aliases comes back to life. 13 13 Missing Persons (NCIS: Los Angeles episode) January 26, 2010. OSP Team Day interrupted when they learn about the emergency page concerning NCIS SPECIAL Agent Dominic Weil and when they look for clues in the kidnapping house, they they they that a group of ruthless South Americans could be responsible. 14 14 LD50 (episode) February 2, 2010. OSP investigate when two career criminals masquerading as Marines are found dead and will soon reveal information that will be auctioned where the weapons will be sold and will be used to launch a bio-terrorist attack. 15 15 Bank Work (episode) February 9, 2010. The OSP team is investigating a military robbery in Iraq that leads them to a jihadist group that hired a robbery crew to reclaim their money that will force the team into a race against the clock to stop the raid from happening but the stakes are raised when Kensi is apparently shot and wounded although all is not what it seems... 16 16 Chinatown (episode) March 2, 2010. A U.S. Navy officer committed suicide by hanging himself, prompting the OSP team to investigate the case, which soon became intense when it emerged that the victim's family was harboring many dark secrets as well as possible threats to national security. 17 17 Full Throttle (episode) March 9, 2010. A U.S. Navy sailor dies in an illegal street race, and the OSP team enters the world of illegal underground street racing to find the killer. 18 18 Blood Brothers (NCIS: Los Angeles Season 1 Episode) March 16, 2010. A Marine dies in a shooting, forcing the OSP team to investigate, ultimately leading them to an operation to smuggle weapons, particularly AK-47s, which ended up in Iraq in the hands of a dangerous street gang. 19 19 Hand in Hand (episode) April 6, 2010. A Marine and MMA fighter found dead outside a nightclub with an OSP team suspect it could be a revenge murder, forcing Sam to go undercover to find the killer. 20 20 Glory (episode) April 27, 2010. A naval officer associated with a famous socialite dies after the car he was in falls off a cliff, but soon there is evidence that the officer was shot, confirming that the death is murder. The OSP team soon goes undercover as VIPs and head into the world of fame in the hope of finding the killer while Detective Marty Dix adjusts to life as a liaison between NCIS and the LAPD. 21 21 Found (episode) May 4, 2010. After months without any new leads, the OSP team move to action when they learn about a new video that shows a group of terrorists threatening the life of a hostage that showed that none other than missing OSP agent Dominic Weil. 22 22 Hunt (episode) May 11, 2010. Two days after saying goodbye to a member of the group, the OSP considers itself an investigation into when an airport shooting leaves one person dead and many questions are asked as Cullen and the team tries to find the head of a terrorist organization at the time In light of the tragic recent events, Hattie has second thoughts about his future as Operations Manager of the Office of Special Projects. 23 23 Burnt (episode) (episode) 18, 2010. A normal day for Cullen soon goes horribly wrong when he learns that his lid has been blown up, forcing him to go on the run while OSP turns up struggling when their computers are hacked, causing them to go offline.
